| <b>1.coexist</b>  |                |  |
| to live together without any problems   | Verb           | They must coexist and live together in peace.                          |
| <b>2.cohesive</b>   |                |  |
| sticking together   | Adjective      | The fifth and sixth grade students bonded and formed a cohesive class. |
| <b>3.coincidence</b>  |                |  |
| events happening together that are an accident, but seem to have been planned; accidental | Noun           | It is no coincidence that God made you, He planned it.                 |
| <b>4.combine</b>  |                |  |
| to mix two or more things together  | Verb           | Combine milk and flour by mixing them together.                        |
| <b>5.commiserate</b>  |                |  |
| to get together with someone to feel sadness  | Verb           | We will commiserate over the terrible tragedy.                         |
| <b>6.committee</b>  |                |  |
| a group of people who meet together to discuss a topic                                    | Noun           | The planting committee is in charge of planting trees.                 |
| <b>7.communication</b>  |                |  |
| the act of talking with someone or exchanging information                                 | Noun           | Speech is one means of communication.                                  |
| <b>8.community</b>  |                |  |
| a place where people live together  | Noun           | Those who live in Rupert form my community.                            |
| <b>9.compare</b>  |                |  |
| to put things together to see how they are the same                                       | Verb           | Let's compare ourselves to find similarities.                          |
| <b>10.compatible</b>  |                |  |
| able to live together and get along well  | Adjective      | They were compatible, so they got along well.                          |
