1.coexist		
to live together without any problems	Verb	They must coexist and live together in peace.
2.cohesive		
sticking together	Adjective	The fifth and sixth grade students bonded and formed a cohesive class.
3.coincidence		
events happening together that are an accident, but seem to have been planned; accidental	Noun	It is no coincidence that God made you, He planned it.
4.combine		
to mix two or more things together	Verb	Combine milk and flour by mixing them together.
5.commiserate		
to get together with someone to feel sadness	Verb	We will commiserate over the terrible tragedy.
6.committee		
a group of people who meet together to discuss a topic	Noun	The planting committee is in charge of planting trees.
7.communication		
the act of talking with someone or exchanging information	Noun	Speech is one means of communication.
8.community		
a place where people live together	Noun	Those who live in Rupert form my community.
9.compare		
to put things together to see how they are the same	Verb	Let's compare ourselves to find similarities.
10.compatible		
able to live together and get along well	Adjective	They were compatible, so they got along well.
